The goal of facilitator training is to teach volunteers to comfortably facilitate a bereavement support group. This training is mandatory to volunteer in the Adult Grief and Bereavement program as well as mandatory for those volunteers wishing to be Program Assistants in the Children's Caring Hearts Program. All new volunteers will need to ensure they have completed this training. Course objectives are to learn about group process, to develop a good understanding of grief, the nature of the helping relationship, how children grieve, and application of core helpings skills to the facilitation of a group.

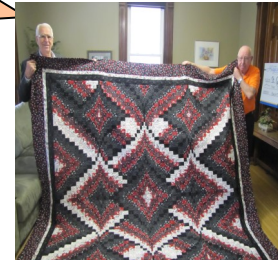
Flu Shots
