### PHIPA – The Personal Health Information Protection Act

The Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004, S.O. 2004. C.3. Sched. A (PHIPA)- see <https://www.ontario.ca/laws/statute/04p03> sets out the rules that persons or organizations (defined as “health care custodians” or “health care providers”) must follow when collecting, using, disclosing, retaining and disposing of personal health information.
