

List of Requirements to Volunteer:

1. Complete Volunteer Application online at <https://www.stjosephshospice.ca> or pick up an application package from the reception desk at Hospice.
2. Interview with Volunteer Program Coordinator to discuss opportunities and assess suitability. Please note, some volunteer roles require a second interview.
3. Provide 2 references, Vulnerable Sector Check, and 2-Step TB test (for direct support roles).
4. Complete Volunteer Orientation (3-hours).
5. Complete online training: WHMIS, AODA & Bill 168 training.
6. Direct Support roles require completion of Hospice Palliative Care Ontario (HPCO) online training.
7. Role specific training.
8. Welcome, you are ready to get started!

- You will be asked to upload a Letter from Hospice in PDF format. This letter requires your legal name and will be provided to you from the St. Joseph’s Hospice – Volunteer Program Coordinator.
